Constructing Unbelievable Bots

Camp Description:

Mukwonago B.E.A.R.s (Building Extremely Awesome Robots) Camp C.U.B. (Constructing Unbelievable Bots) offers two sessions: a morning session that runs from 8 – 12 and an afternoon session that runs from 12:30 – 4:30 p.m. each day.

Camp C.U.B. is a five-day, fun-filled creative, team building, and learning experience for children. Participants will have a great time while learning about basic principles of design, computer programming, the engineering process, science and teamwork. Guided by B.E.A.R.s team members, children will design, build, program and test robots using LEGO robotics components.

The week will culminate with a program for parents highlighting the week's activities, as well as a demonstration by the high school robotics team illustrating the challenges in FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) Robotics Competition (FRC). Participants will also receive a camp shirt on the last day of camp.

Each daily session will include a light snack and a beverage. Please be sure to indicate any dietary allergies or restrictions on admission forms.

Session Dates/Hours:

Camp C.U.B. runs Monday – Friday, July 12 – 16, 2010

Morning session - Please drop off your child between 7:50 and 8 a.m. each day.

Children must be picked up no later than 12:10 p.m.

Afternoon session – Please drop off your child between 12:20 and 12:30 p.m. each day.

Children must be picked up no later than 4:40 p.m.

Participants:

Campers should be entering grades four through eight in the fall 2010. No experience is necessary. Enroll with a friend to double the fun. Register early, space is limited.

Cost:

Cost of each session is \$100 if paid by June 10. A \$15 late fee will be added to all registrations received after June 10. No registration will be accepted after June 21.

Transfers to another session (if the session is not full) or another child are allowed. There will be no refunds. A waiting list will be formed for each session after the maximum capacity of 20 campers per session is reached.

Sign In and Sign Out Procedures:

A parent or guardian, or other authorized individuals, 16 years or older, must sign each child in and out of the camp every day. The only people that your child can be released to are those you indicate by written permission. In an emergency, call 262-470-3412 to authorize someone else to pick up your child.

Absences:

Please call 262-470-3412 after 7 a.m. but before 8 a.m., or between noon and 12:30 p.m. to report an absence. If you leave a message, clearly state your child's full name. If we do not receive a message, we will try to confirm the absence by phone.

Illness or Injury at Camp:

If your child is ill or injured at camp, we will notify you as soon as possible so that you can pick up your child. In an emergency, we will call 911 and emergency personnel.

Medications will not be administered by camp staff. If your child requires medications during the camp session, a parent/guardian must be present to administer the medications.
